Scarecrow Contest Information:

- The scarecrow contest will take place in downtown Emmett during the Harvest Festival. Scarecrows will be on assigned light poles on Main St.
- The scarecrows will be on display from Thursday, September 28 to November 1, 2023. You can make arrangements with the Chamber to take them down earlier if needed.
- Judging will take place on Saturday, September 30, 2023, at 9am. Winners will be announced at Harvest Festival Gem County Chamber of Commerce Booth 11am, 9/30/23.
- Event Coordinators reserves the right to remove entries. Participants are encouraged to create positive, creative and nonviolent family friendly scarecrows.
- Scarecrow participants are required to monitor the health and well-being of their scarecrow for the duration of the event.
- Participants will be asked to remove their scarecrows if it deteriorates beyond reason.

Scarecrow Contest Registration:

- Those who wish to participate in the scarecrow contest must submit an entry form.
- Each participant will be assigned a designated light pole by the Event Coordinators.
- Scarecrows can be set up Sept. 25th, through Sept. 29th, 2023. Make sure you secure your scarecrow for stormy weather.

Scarecrow Construction:

- All scarecrow entries will remain on display outside September 29th through November 1st, 2023. Their construction should be durable and all ornamentation securely attached. No perishable goods may be used. The event coordinators reserve the right to remove any scarecrow that does not hold up to the natural elements.
- Each scarecrow must have horizontal support. This support is needed as each scarecrow will be tied to a light post for display.
- Your exhibit may include more than one figure but no more than three.
