Scarecrow Contest Information

- Open to all local clubs / teams / groups / non-profits and businesses.
- It is 100% FREE to enter your scarecrow into the contest.
- **LIMITED SPACES AVAILABLE.** Applications must be turned in to the Chamber by **September 9th, 2024.**
- Organization name, web/social links, volunteer/team members, description, creative processes and other information about your scarecrow can be included and will be shared on the voting website.
- The scarecrow contest will take place in downtown Emmett during the Harvest Festival. Scarecrows will be on assigned light poles on Main Street
- The scarecrows will be on display from Thursday, September 26 to November 1, 2024. You can make arrangements with the Chamber to take them down earlier if needed.
- In-Person Festival Judging will take place on Saturday, September 28, 2024, at 9am. Winners will be announced at the Gem County Chamber of Commerce Booth 11am the same day.
- Online Community Judging will continue throughout the length of display and winners will be announced on November 4th.



Scarecrow Construction



- All scarecrow entries will remain on display outside September 26th through November 1st, 2024.
- Participants are encouraged to create positive, creative and non-violent/controversial, family friendly scarecrows.
- Each scarecrow must have horizontal support. This support is needed as each scarecrow will be tied to a light post for display.
- Their construction should be durable and all ornamentation securely attached.
- No perishable goods may be used.
- Your exhibit may include more than one figure but no more than three.
- Scarecrow participants are required to monitor the health and well-being of their scarecrow for the duration of the event.
- Participants will be asked to remove their scarecrows if it deteriorates beyond reason.
- Event Coordinators reserves the right to remove entries for inappropriate décor or if participants do not remove deteriorated scarecrows after being requested to do so.
